Possible choices for professional growth activities

(Choose from this list, or choose an activity of your own with elements of professional growth and measurement)

Self-Evaluation

- Make a video or audio recording of a teaching episode and write a report of your findings
- Visit another classroom and write a report of your findings and impact on your teaching
- Make a professional presentation to your board or another group and write a summary report
- Your choice

Peer Evaluation

- Ask a peer to review a video or audio recording of a teaching episode and share a written review with you
- Ask a peer to make an observation visit to your classroom and share a conference of results
- Work with a group of peers on a particular project of interest and write a summary report
- Be a mentor to another teacher and write a summary report
- Your choice

Supervisory Evaluation

- Standard classroom observation with pre- and post- conferences
- Make a video or audio recording of a teaching episode and ask your supervisor to review and share findings
- Ask for a verbatim transcript of a teaching episode and review the results together
- Complete the Gallup Teacher Perceiver interview with conference office of education personnel and review the findings
- Your choice

Parent Evaluation

- Conduct a parent survey and write a report of your findings
- Ask a parent to observe a teaching episode, write a report, and conference the results
- Your choice

Student Evaluation

- Conduct a student survey of your class and analyze the results in writing
- Conduct a formal goal-setting activity with your students, write your plan, then report your results
- Your choice

Other

- Conduct a survey of alumni of your class/room and write a summary of results
- Form a study group on a particular topic or topics and report your activities at year-end
- Conduct focused home visits with your students and report the experience
